Programs At A Glance ~ Child Care Council of Dutchess and Putnam, Inc.

Child Care Resource and Referral (Dutchess and Putnam)

- Provides information to parents on locating child care, consumer education, referrals, subsidies, services for families
- Recruits child care providers, provides start-up information and technical assistance in meeting regulatory requirements
- Provides the community with education on child care issues and current data needed in planning for community services
- Supports employers in planning, implementing and providing employee child care services

Child Care Registration (Dutchess and Putnam)

- Provides supervision of 106 family day care homes in Dutchess and 26 in Putnam
- Provides supervision of 31 school age programs in Dutchess, and 7 in Putnam
- Includes processing new and renewal applications, monitoring and inspecting programs, providing technical assistance and investigating complaints

Child and Adult Care Food Program (Dutchess and Putnam)

- Supports group and family day care providers in providing nutritious, healthful meals and snacks to children in their care
- Manages the CACFP federal reimbursement program for participating providers

Health Care Consultancy Services (Dutchess and Putnam)

- Registered Nurse on staff conducts training classes on health issues for child care providers
- Reviews and approves health care plans for medication administration

Day Care Subsidy Administration (Putnam)

Manages the subsidized day care program

Regional Infant-Toddler Technical Assistance Center (Dutchess, Putnam and Ulster)

Provides training and technical assistance to providers who care for infants and toddlers

Resource Lending Library (Dutchess and Putnam)

Onsite lending library of toys, equipment, teaching units and professional resources

Mobile Resource Lending Library (Dutchess)

 Council van stocked with toys, games, teaching units, children's books, and professional resources to enhance programs



- In 2011 the following groups of consumers were served in Dutchess and Putnam Counties:
 - **▼ 1,037 families** received information about finding child care.
 - **♥ 1,519 children** were referred to child care programs.
 - ▼ There were a total of **10,126 slots** for child care in day care centers, group family day care homes, family day care homes, and school age programs.
 - ◆ **Approximately 1,800 children** at nutritious food as part of the Child and Adult Care Food Program
- Approximately **800 volunteer hours** supported the work of the Child Care Council.

Economic Impact:

- There are approximately **1,800 employed** in Dutchess and Putnam Counties in the early care and education workforce.
- * 74% of Child Care Council **staff** reside in Dutchess County, 10% in Putnam County, and 16% in Ulster County.
- Regulated early care and education programs (day care centers, family and group family child care, school age child care, Head Start, and Universal Pre-Kindergarten) provide care for approximately 12,000 children in Dutchess and Putnam Counties so that parents can work or go to school.







Into your care you are trusted To nurture and care for the young, And for all of your everyday heroics, Your talents and skills go unsung.






You wipe tears from the eyes of the injured. You rock babies brand new in your arms. You encourage the shy and unsure child. You make sure they are safe from all harm.
